

**MILLERS CREEK SPECIAL DISTRICT
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING
PROPOSED ADOPTION OF NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2026-2027 through 2029-2030**

The Millers Creek Special District ("MCSD"), a dependent special district created by the City of Jacksonville, Florida, through Ordinance No. 2014-700-E ("Ordinance"), gives notice, pursuant to Sec. 197.3632, Florida Statutes, of the proposed adoption of a non-ad valorem assessment on parcels and lots within the MCSD for fiscal years 2026-2027 through 2029-2030 and of a public hearing at which the non-ad valorem assessment will be adopted.

The schedule of assessments is as follows:

Each lot in the MCSD subject to assessment as proposed, will be assessed the sum of \$3,000.00 annually, if adopted for fiscal years 2026-2027 through fiscal year 2029-2030.

All assessments will be collected by the Duval County Tax Collector.

A public hearing will be conducted by the Board of Supervisors of the MCSD on July 13, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. at 6720 Atlantic Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida, for the purpose of considering adoption of a Resolution approving the non-ad valorem assessment to be levied annually for the fiscal years listed above at the level listed above, as well as the non-ad valorem assessment roll. All affected property owners have a right to appear at this public hearing to voice any objections to the assessments and, in addition, all affected property owners have the right to file written objections to the assessments within twenty (20) days of the publication of this notice. Written objections should be sent to Millers Creek Special District, P.O. Box 47375, Jacksonville, Florida, 32247.
