NOTICE is hereby given that the following **Public Hearing** will be held at **City Hall**, in the Council Chambers, **1st floor, 117 W. Duval Street, St. James Building**, concerning the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE 2026-635, AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING & STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORD. CODE; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION FOR PRESTON H. HASKELL, III ON MUSEUM CIRCLE IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF 2 HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS ON MUSEUM CIRCLE; RENAMING THE ROADWAY CURRENTLY IDENTIFIED AS "MUSEUM CIRCLE" TO "HASKELL WAY" IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 PURSUANT TO SECTION 745.105 (PUBLIC STREET NAME CHANGES), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING & STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORD. CODE; WAIVING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS 745.105(I)(2) & (I)(3) (PUBLIC STREET NAME CHANGES), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING & STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE, WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE BE DECEASED FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS AND THAT THE HONOREE LIVE WITHIN 5 MILES OF THE STREET NAME CHANGE FOR AT LEAST 10 YEARS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE, ONCE ENACTED, TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DIVISION, ADDRESSING UNIT FOR PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION AND COORDINATION WITH THE TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION, THE APPLICANT, 911 EMERGENCY, THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE & RESCUE DEPARTMENT, THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
