The City of Jacksonville proposes to adopt the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE 2026-644

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE PUBLIC PARK CURRENTLY KNOWN AS “CEDAR POINT PRESERVE,” WHICH INCLUDES CERTAIN PARCELS OF REAL PROPERTY IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2, LOCATED ON CEDAR POINT ROAD NEAR DARCY DRIVE AND 7 CREEKS TRAIL, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, PURSUANT TO SECTION 122.105 (PUBLIC BUILDINGS, PUBLIC FACILITIES AND PUBLIC PARKS NAMING AND RENAMING PROCEDURES), ORDINANCE CODE, TO BE KNOWN AS “MIDDLEBROOK PRESERVE”; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
